PEACE AT ALL COST

The desire to avoid conflict is good. "Let's just all get along" sounds like good advice. But squelching open and honest disagreement and unaddressed grievances gives birth to more conflict. Such issues need to be addressed. And it needs to be done in a loving and caring way. Frivolous ones need to be dismissed.

HONEST DISAGREEMENT

But some of the sect of the Pharisees who had believed stood up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them and to direct them to observe the Law of Moses." The apostles and the elders came together to look into this matter.

SERIOUS GRIEVANCE

Now at this time while the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic Jews against the native Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving of food. ... "Therefore, brethren, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task."

Acts 6:1.3

FRIVOLOUS CONTROVERSIES

But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the Law, for they are unprofitable and worthless.

TRUTH AT ALL COST

"Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth."

John 17:17

If anyone advocates a different doctrine and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the doctrine conforming to godliness, he is conceited and understands nothing; but he has a morbid interest in controversial questions and disputes about words, out of which arise envy, strife, abusive language, evil suspicions, and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain.

1 Timothy 6:3-5

Peace is desirable. But to pursue peace by way of appeasement (the granting of concessions to maintain peace) and disregarding the truth of the gospel only produce further conflict. Here is an old item I found in my files:

NOTHING NEW UNDER THE SUN

Years ago, in order to have a peaceful and harmonious church, a minister (name not important) practiced the principle, "Truth If Possible, Peace At All Costs." Instead of peace, chaos ensued. And it always will. "Peace If Possible, Truth At All Costs*" must be the guiding principle. For without truth, love is not possible, and without love all is lost.

That's on its way home


And sometimes we laugh together
